REVIEW PROCESS OVERVIEW

- 1. Each publication is evaluated by at least two independent reviewers from outside the author(s) unit.
- 2. In the event that the text is produced in a foreign language, one of the reviewers shall be an affiliated person from a foreign academic institution based in a country other than the country of the author(s).
- 3. The reviewers' identities are kept secret from the author(s), and the author's/authors' identity/identities is/are kept secret from the reviewers' (*double-blind review process*), in other case the reviewer is obliged to sign a statement that there is no apparent or actual conflict of interest between the reviewer and the author(s), i.e.: direct personal relations (consanguinity, legal relations, conflict), professional relationships or direct scientific collaboration within a 2-year period preceding the review.
- 4. The review shall be prepared in writing (the reviewer shall fill in the review form received from the Editorial Office and may submit it either via e-mail or traditional mail). The review shall close with an unequivocal opinion as to whether or not the article should be accepted for publication.
- 5. The review form is available from the journal's website.
- 6. The names of reviewers who collaborate with the journal are published annually.
